I had a little adjusting time to get back the daily job routine, but I managed through, slowly coming back to it.

Today I keep in mind this image of open minded people, curious and overwhelming. I am convinced that they are not only in south america, and I clearly intend to go meet them, firstly on my way from france to asia, and then on my way from alaska to ushuaia, on this road well admired by cyclo-tourists.

WHO AM I?



I'm Antoine, I'm 27.

French guy, originally from Nantes in the west coast of france, I came to paris for studies. After bachelor's degree in network and telecommunication, I found my place as broadcast engineer.

Today, I work for several television channels in Paris.

Little bit of an adventurer and good handyman, I like get myself in new challenges, to find the limits and beat them. This trip is a little bit of that.

THE PROJECT

WHO ?

I'm leaving on my own, but I expect to share on regular basis my position and my journeys on the internet, expecting to find peoples on the way, and eventually stop by on my way to see the countries otherwise than by biking. Or sharing a couple of kilometers with other world-trip bikers if we ever meet?

WHAT ?

The idea is to go worldwild. Going around different continents during two years to meet people, their country, their culture. Jumping in with no prejudice, and make an opinion by myself.

The itinary itself is only a rough idea, I know by experience that it will change according to the people I'll meet.

WHY ?

Because when you tasted it, you can't stop. I know that travel is a uniq exerieence, human forging and very rewarding. The hapiness involved in the process of meeting peples, sharing a minute, a day, or a week with them is hard to describe in few words.

It's also a personal challenge, pushing back my own limit to find new ones, see how far I can go.

And finally, it's the need to leave my actual lifestyle, too daily, to go take another dose of unknown.

And for those who are still not convinced about why you could get involved in that kind of trips, I'd simply add this quote from two world bikers from belgium :

«we came to make a world tour because we wanted it, !»

THE PROJECT

WHEN?

The D-day for departure is for the beginning of April 2014. The arrival, on its side, remains unknown. It will depend on the journey, on the meetings, on the desires.

WHERE?

I begin by crossing the Eurasian continent, from west to east, then I'll cross Oceania to finish in New Zealand.

After that, I intend to connect Alaska to Patagonia, crossing the North and South American continent.

HOW?

On a bike. After my trip in Latin America, I became sure that it is the best way for my kind of travel. It's as green as it's inexpensive, it's on one hand fast enough to travel through entire countries, and it's on the other hand slow enough to meet people and enjoy the show. So I'll go back on the same type of bike than on my last trip : **a recumbent bike.**



THE TRAVEL

OVERVIEW

I discovered the biking way of traveling three years ago: a trip opportunity, coming a little bit from nowhere, and here I am, traveling up through south america on a bicycle. A crazy idea that drove me for 7 months through different countries of south and central america. This travel was a wonder, full of discoveries and people.

Today I'm back for a world tour, or rather, for **My world trip**. I prepare this travel following my instinct, leaving me free to modify things if I want to, **I want this travel to match me**, not the opposite. It's also one of the reasons I'm going alone. I'll go on my own rhythm, and if I'm late, then that may be for better or worse !

The goal of this travel is to go explore : the countries (and the prejudice we have on them), their inhabitants, and as far as it's possible, sharing a story, a smile, a complicity, a moment... I hope that I'll be able to share with you as much as I can about those instants on the website.

I'm jumping in with no real «return» date, though for technical reasons I had to point one (at least to estimate the budget). I'm feeling free on the itinerary, because I know it will evolve according to people and some unpredictable events...

The target is not to set a time-record, or a «as much countries as possible» record. The target is just to travel and to enjoy as much as possible of this new adventure.

The departure date is for april 2014.

THE TRAVEL

ITINERARY

In order to rallye South-East Asia on the first time, I choosed to go through the Noth of the Hymalayas.

For the Amaerican part, I'll go from Alaska to rejoin Patagonia (south-en of Argentina), then I'll go to Buenos Aeres to take a plane back home.



This travel plan is only a sketch, it's obviously going to change during the travel, according to the unpredictable. Depending on the expediting, the roads quality or the weather, I might also go by other meanings (hitch-hiking, bus, boat, seaplane, dromedary...).

THE TRAVEL

COUNTRIES TO VISIT

Estimated countries to be traveled.

Europe:

France, Switzerland, Germany, Austria, Slovakia, Hungary, Croatia, Serbia, Romania and Bulgaria.

Asia:

Turkey, Georgia, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Iran, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Kyrgyzstan, China, Mongolia, Japan, Vietnam, Laos, Burma, Thailand, Cambodia, Malaysia.

Oceania:

Indonesia, Australia, New Zealand.

Americas:

United States, Canada, Mexico, Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, Nicaragua, Costa Rica, Panama, Colombia, Venezuela, Ecuador, Peru, Bolivia, Paraguay, Argentina, Chile.

CALENDAR

The itinerary has been calculated on the basis of 350 km a week, or 50 km per day. More realistically, it is 70 km a day, 5 days a week (thus leaving two days of rest).

According to this estimation, this journey shall last two years.

A provisional map of my progress be found in annex.

THE TRAVEL

ON A BIKE ?

After traveling latin America, on a bike, I can't imagine this travel with another way of traveling. It has many advantages :

- It's quiet and smooth, due to its lack of engine, and if i have to spend two years seating on it, I would greatly enjoy the calm of pedaling rather than the noise of a motor.
- it's independant, I can go through in total autonomy, no petrol refill issue.
- It's green (no engine) and inexpensive (spare parts more standardized than in the car industrie, easy to fix by yourself, few maintenance)
- it's «meeting friendly», due to the lack of motor, of helmet, or of bodywork, you're directly in touch with people on the side of the road, even without getting off the bike, it gets people in touch.

And to that, adds the advantages of recumbent biking :

- • A performance gain (or the same performance with less effort).
- • Matchless comfort (thanks to a real seat) and natural panoramic view.
- • Difficult to steal and resell.

I already experimented a long trip on a «bent» (other name of the recumbents bike), on more than 8000km in latin american in 2010. So I already know that it fits perfectly to this kind of travel. whatever climate or terrain, and so do I.



THE BUDGET

ESTIMATIONS

In order to set a journey budget as precise as possible, I split it to understand what it could be. That shall let me go more regally composed. It's still submit to evolution until departure.

The planning budget is based on the purchase of every pieces of equipments required to travel two years. It should consider the equipment I already possess, the subventions and grants.

To make this trip I have a persoanl contribution of 15 000€, my savings of those last few years. This contibution is completed with the equipments I already have, bought during my previous travels, so some equipment I don't need to buy.

I'm now missing 11 150€.

To find this extra amount, I shall now make partnerships.

PARTNERSHIPS

MY NEEDS

- Equipments :
Regarding this journey, I need a lot of equipments, and specially some highly reliable and lightweight materials, often expensive materials. My journey will go smoothly or not, mainly depending on the reliability of this equipment I'll carry. So I'll take any kind of equipment, given or lended.
- Finance:
As I said before, the required equipment can quickly become expensive (as it shall be high quality and sometime High-tech). That makes me looking for fundings, discounts, vouchers, in order to be able to acquire this equipment.
- Logistic :
This travel also requires a logistic part in order to have the equipment transitting from a continent to another, or event just to communicate, wether it's for daily update or to be able to communicate, wheter it's for regular update or emergency communication in case of problem. So every help is warmly welcome!

COMPENSATIONS

I'm of course enclined to compensations for any help given, wether it is :

First a website visibility, a webpage is dedicated to sponsors on the project website, with a link to your company website.

Then I can supply during the travel some press quality pictures and videos of your equipments in live condition, in different countries. Those images are royalty free.

On my time back, I can supply you a complete file on the equipments involved, they're often used intensively, and in many different situations (altitude, temperatures, humidity, shocks...), their strenght and weakness on the use, and their evolution on time. Those data can be very helpfull if you use them for the design of your next range.
